

Information as translated from the Herr Crest Document below

This is information on the Coat of Arms between 1286 through 1656 from Gender book v. Baden & Upper Rhine. From 1656 through 1869, No records were available.

The links all relate to web site info about thee names and places in the translation.

Buchardus Herr, in the year 1286, was The Mayor of Constance (on Lake Constance). By 1326, he was referred to by the populous as “Sir”, “Der Herr”. In 1348, he purchased a parcel of land called the Rich-forest (Reichenhauer) fiefdom (Lehen) in the village of [Allensbach](#).

Conrad Herr, 1393 was a resident of [Laufenburg](#). Henslie Herr in 1397 oversaw the land called Kehrhof and Kirchensatz (church estates) in the village of [Wolfinswil](#) and by 1399 became “Lord” in [Laufenburg](#) and in 1403 was the “Overlord” of the Black Forest Region.

From the above, decedents of the Herr’s also lived in [Markdorf](#), [Markelfingen](#).

Claus, “Der Herr” of the village of [Messkirch](#) in 1383, was also given a rich-forest fiefdom in the village of [Goggingen](#).

In 1397, Berthold Herr, Senior of the church of [Achdorf](#), purchased the entire village of Achdorf.

In 1429, Johannes Herr in the village of Engen Germany was the Probst (?) in [Zurzach](#). (Switzerland)

Konrad Herr, alias “Pfaff” was in 1515 the Priest (Pfarrer) in village of [Immendingen](#).

Rudi Herr, a townsman in the village [Rottweil](#), also a “[Wurttemberg’s](#)” loan(?) man and would dispose of sentences in the court of Heil and was a state judge by 1442.

Benno Herr, was Lord Marshall for [Schleingen](#).

Heini Herr, of the village of Huser (?), was the Head of the hospital and his son, Caspar, was matriculated in the University of Freiburg in 1510.

Adam Herr, licensed by the early right government as forester in [Ensisheim](#). Then, as overlord of the [Baron Truchsess of Waldburg](#), he received from emperor [Rudolf II](#) in [Regensburg](#) in 1594 a coat of arms with articles. Herr Branches are in Basel, Villingen, Waldshut and on the Bodensee.

Hans Herr was Mayor of [Basel](#) and head of city council.

Niclaus Herr was lord of that town council and at the city court around 1510.

Ludwig Herr, Chairman of that Council and Court of Justice

Conradus Herr died in 1649 and his wife [Judith von Jestetten](#) died in 1609 were buried in [Muenster](#) near Freiburg.

The brothers Heinrich Herr, scribe at the Junkern (?) of Hornstein in Swabia, and Andreas Herr wagmeister(?) were recommended to the rich special [Umbrella Protection called "Shutz & Schirm"](#) around 1656.

Under your protection and umbrella (Latin Sub tuum praesidium) is one of the oldest Marian prayers and a Marian Antiphon. Here is from the web.

"There is evidence from the third century in a Greek papyrus fragment in the John Rylands Library No. 470. Therefore, it is Pope Paul VI. according to, "venerable and grand in content because of his age". Striking is in particular the use of the detectable since Origen's concept of the Gods-in-law (gr. Θεοτόκος theotókos). It shows that this content of faith was already familiar to the early Church (see Gregory of Nazianzus, Oratio 24.10 Migne PG 35, 1180). The first mariological dogma statement was made at the Council of Ephesus (431 AD). [1]"

(Our wife, our mediator, our advocate.
